Who They Are

Our Families Come from **51 different zip codes** and **15 different school districts.**

For bereavement support services they come because the death of a:

- ∘ 54.43% A Parent or Parental figure
- 22.28% A Grandparent
- ∘ 10.89% A Sibling
- 9.11% Another Relative
- 3.29% A Friend

And those died from:

- ∘ 50.63% An Illness
- 42.57% A Traumatic Event
- ∘ 6.8% COVID

For those children and families who are supported due to an adult caretaker's diagnosis of a serious medical condition:

- 89% of the adults have some form of cancer
- 10.81% of the adults have a non-cancer diagnosis

For those children and families who are supported due to a child's diagnosis of a serious medical condition:

- ∘ 62.5% some form of cancer
- 7.5% heart defect
- 7.5% Muscular Dystrophy
- 22.5% Other serious medical condition

What They Say

- 100% would recommend Tu Nidito to others
- 92% felt that they feel understood and supported by Tu Nidito
- **91%** shared they have to tools to navigate their journeys though a death or a serious medical condition
- **89%** of caregivers report that they feel more prepared to support their child






