

2024 Community Impact Report






Dear Friends and Supporters,

2024 was a year of profound impact and meaningful growth at Tu Nidito. With your unwavering support, we continued our mission to create a compassionate community of acceptance and understanding for children, teens, young adults, and caregivers grieving the diagnosis of a serious medical condition or the death of a loved one.

Because of your generosity and belief in our mission, Tu Nidito provided direct support to **1,117 individuals** through our support groups and one-on-one services, and reached an additional **1,007 people** through our community education and grief response programs. This year, **210 volunteers** — including direct service, indirect support, and board members — gave **8,640 hours** of their time to ensure that *no child grieves alone*.



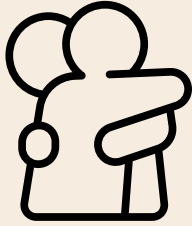

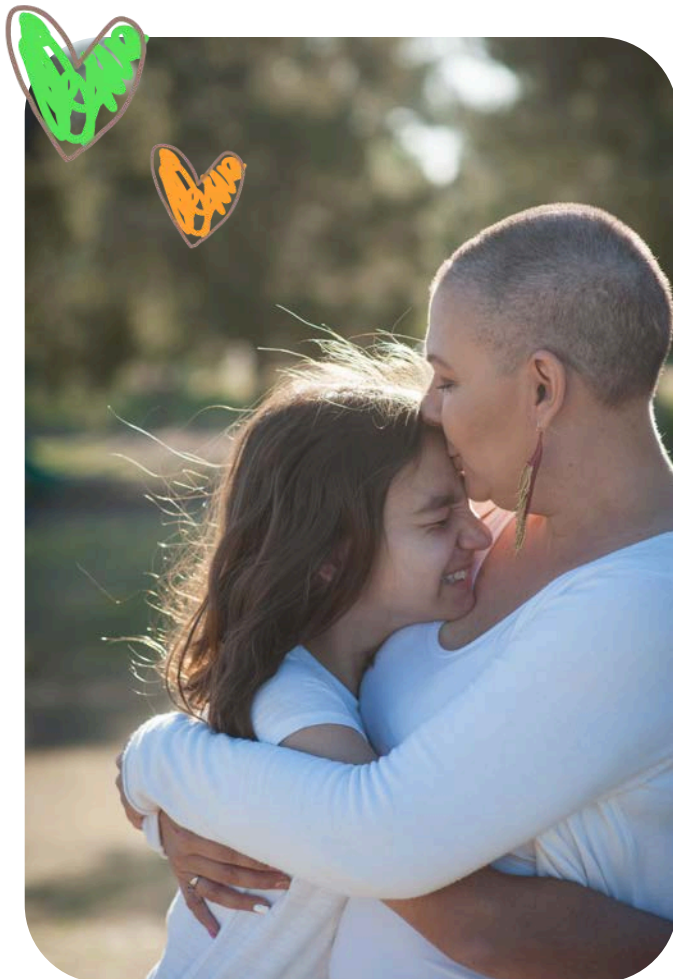
